

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE – COUNCIL MINUTES WORK SESSION – OCTOBER 23, 2017

Borough Council held a Work Session on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building. Council President Joy Kemper called the meeting to order with the following persons present: Council Members Joy Kemper, Michael Sullenberger, Tim Lawson, and Bob Kauffman. Mayor John Chase and Borough Manager/Secretary/Police Chief Ken Work were also present at the meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENT: There was no public comment.

FIRE POLICE REQUEST – SOLANCO HIGH SCHOOL: Council was in receipt of a letter from the East Drumore Township Supervisors requesting the assistance of the Quarryville Fire Company Fire Police to help with traffic for a soccer tournament scheduled for November 4, 2017 between 7:00 AM and 12 Noon, at Solanco High School. Councilman Sullenberger offered a motion to approve the use of the Quarryville Fire Department Fire Police for that event. Councilman Kauffman seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

BUDGET WORKSHOP: There was nothing new regarding the budget. The tentative budget will be presented to Council at the November 6, 2017 Council meeting.

EXECUTIVE SESSION – PERSONNEL ISSUE: At 7:05 PM, Council President Kemper called for a motion to enter in to an Executive Session for Personnel Issues. Councilman Sullenberger made that motion and it was seconded by Councilman Lawson. The motion passed and Council entered into Executive Session.

RETURN TO REGULAR SESSION: At 7:22 PM, Councilman Sullenberger made a motion to return to Regular Session. Councilman Kauffman seconded the motion and the motion to return to Regular Session passed.

NOMINATION FOR CHIEF OF POLICE: Councilman Kauffman moved that Clark A. Bearinger be nominated for the position of Police Chief for the Borough, subject to his successful completion of all non-competitive examinations administered by the Quarryville Borough Civil Service Commission, and further authorize the Borough Manager to present Bearinger with a Conditional Offer of Employment. Councilman Sullenberger seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS: Councilman Kauffman suggested that the Girls Softball League should be contacted and it should be explained to them why the fee schedule was put in place for the Memorial Park fields. The Borough Manager will make that contact.

NEW BUSINESS: None.

ADJOURNMENT: At 7:26 PM, Council President Kemper called for a motion to adjourn. Councilman Sullenberger offered the motion. The motion was seconded by Councilman Lawson and the motion carried.
