

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE – COUNCIL MINUTES

WORK SESSION – JULY 22, 2019

Borough Council held a work session on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building. Council President Joy Kemper called the meeting to order with the following persons present: Council Members Joy Kemper, Rick Aument, Diane Hastings, and Jim Kreider. Borough Manager/Secretary Ken Work, Maintenance Superintendent Bill Lamparter, Chief Clark Bearinger, and Scott Peiffer were also present at the meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

BUDGET WORKSHOP: The Borough Manager presented Council with paperwork showing across the board pay raises of 1%, 2%, and 3%. Also shown was total salary costs with both replacing Scott Peiffer's position in Maintenance and without replacing that position. In addition, several scenarios involving the Borough's Health Insurance, to include Spousal Exclusion, Spousal Surcharge, and Employee Contribution were also presented.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: At 7:17 PM Council President Kemper called for a motion to enter into Executive Session for a Personnel matter. Councilman Kreider offered that motion with Councilman Aument seconding. A vote was taken and the motion was approved.

RETURN TO REGULAR SESSION: At 8:05 PM Councilwoman Hastings offered a motion to return to Regular Session. Councilman Aument seconded that motion and Council returned to regular session.

Councilwoman Hastings asked Bill Lamparter and Scott Peiffer to sit down with Clint Herr and try to do a time management study to determine if it would be possible to complete all of the Borough's work without filling Scott Peiffer's position in 2020. After a discussion all agreed to look at that possibility.

The Manager asked Bill Lamparter and Clark Bearinger if they could work on their respective working budgets to present at the next regular council meeting on 5 August 2019. Council President Kemper advised that Council will continue working on pay raise and benefit options and no decisions will be made until all of Council has an opportunity to have input.

The Manager presented Council with a list of appointment positions whose terms expire in 2019. The Manager will contact those persons and see if they're interested in serving another term and report the findings back to Council at the August meeting.

ADJOURNMENT: At 8:36 PM, Council President Joy Kemper called for a motion to adjourn. Councilwoman Hastings offered that motion with Councilman Kreider seconding. The motion to adjourn was unanimously approved.
