

QUARRYVILLE BOROUGH AUTHORITY

APRIL 28, 2026

The Authority held its work session meeting on April 28, 2026 at the Municipal Building. Chairman John Chase called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with Authority members Mike Mankin, Brian Braightmeyer, Brad Groff, Authority Manager Bill Lamparter, WWTP Chief Operator Clint Herr and Administrative Assistant Kelly Wyatt present. Donald Evans was absent.

Public Comment: No public comment.

Approval of Minutes: It was moved by John Chase and seconded by Mike Mankin that the minutes of the March 17, 2026 Authority meeting be approved. The motion was unanimously approved.

Financial Report and Monthly Bills: It was moved by Mike Mankin and seconded by Brian Braightmeyer to approve the March 31, 2026 financial report and ratify the March 2026 invoices in the amount of \$238,348.64. The motion was unanimously approved.

Chief Operator Report: Clint Herr reported that everything is good. Brian Braightmeyer mentioned that tours given to Council members were well received and comments were complimentary.

Engineers Report: Rettew Engineering: The Authority reviewed the monthly report from Rettew and accepted it as written.

Approval of Phase 2 North Hess Street Water Main Replacement Proj: Brad Groff moved to move forward with Phase 2 of the N Hess Street Water Main Replacement Project. This includes Rettew's \$80,200.00 estimate for engineering costs. This motion was seconded by Brian Braightmeyer and passed unanimously.

Sewer Service Agreement: A motion was made by John Chase and seconded by Mike Mankin to approve the sewer service at 25 Ridgewood Road. The motion was unanimously approved.

Polyethylene Water Line Installation Requests: Resident's Carl Reynolds and Peter Ferguson are requesting approval to use NSF Polyethylene waterline to replace galvanized water pipe. Motion to approve this request made by Brian Braightmeyer, seconded by John Chase. Passed unanimously.

Clean Enterprise requested permission to use 2" CTS Blue NSF Polyethylene pipe to replace the 2" water line. Brad Groff made a motion to approve the request with Mike Mankin as second. Motion passed unanimously. Solid Rock requested permission to run a new 2" CTS Blue NSF polyethylene line. The new 2" line will be

tapped off of North Hess Street and the old line will be abandoned from East State Street. John Chase moved to approve this request with a second from Mike Mankin. Motion passed unanimously.

South Lime Street Roadway Patches: Quotes were received to repair the roadway at South Lime and State streets from the water main break that happened over the winter. The roadway patches will have to be done per the PennDOT H.O.P. permit. As of this date, R.T. Price is the lowest bidder with one quote still outstanding. Brian Braightmeyer moved to accept the quote from R.T. Price, unless the quote from B.R. Kreider is lower. John Chase seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Public Comment: No public comment.

Adjournment: There being no further business, it was moved by Mike Mankin and seconded by Brian Braightmeyer that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was unanimously approved and the meeting was adjourned at 7:28 pm.
