

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE – COUNCIL MINUTES

WORK SESSION – AUGUST 9, 2021

Borough Council held its Work Session on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building. Council President Joy Kemper called the meeting to order with the following persons present: Council Members Susan Noel, Brian Braightmeyer, Rick Aument, Mike Sullenberger and Diane Hastings. Mayor Joseph Bledsoe and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer were also in attendance.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

OLD BUSINESS:

PLGIT Investment Account- After a brief discussion on the Pennsylvania Local Government Investment Trust (PLGIT) investment account which was tabled from the August 2, 2021 Regular Council meeting, a motion was made by Councilwoman Hastings to open an account with the Pennsylvania Local Government Investment Trust in the amount of \$890,000.00 with 50% (\$445,000.00) of the funds invested in a PLGIT/PRIME liquid money market account and 50% (\$445,000.00) invested in PLGIT/TERM and or the CD Purchase Program. The motion was seconded by Councilman Aument. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance Revision - Chapter 337- There was a brief discussion concerning changes to Chapter 337 regarding on street dumpster/storage pods. The issue will be reviewed at Streets/Infrastructure/Parks meeting on August 10, 2021.

NEW BUSINESS:

Budget Discussion- The Manager and Council began to discuss the 2022 budget. Council made some suggestions as we went over General Fund revenues and expenses.

LegalShield/IDShield Benefit- The Manager presented the LegalShield/IDShield program as a possible benefit to the employees. The program provides ID protection as well as legal assistance to an individual or family. The Manager was instructed to get an idea of how many employees would be interested in the program if it was offered as a benefit funded or unfunded by the Borough.

ARPA Funds- The Manager handed out an updated information packet containing frequently answered questions on the ARPA funds (COVID Relief Funds) which are being disbursed to municipalities. The information will help guide what to do with those funds.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: At 7:30 PM, Council President Joy Kemper called for a motion to enter into Executive Session for personnel issues regarding non-uniform employees. Councilwoman Hastings offered that motion and Councilwoman Noel seconded the motion. The motion to enter into Executive Session was passed unanimously.

RETURN TO REGULAR SESSION: At 7:34 PM, Council returned to Regular Session.

A motion to waive Memorial Park user fees for the Quarryville Fire Company's annual Trunk or Treat Night in October was made by Councilman Braightmeyer and seconded by Councilwoman Hastings. The motion passed unanimously.

Borough Manager Scott Peiffer reported that the first Chalk It Up Quarryville contest was a huge success with 28 participants and very positive feedback from the community.

ADJOURNMENT: At 8:48 PM, Council President Kemper called for a motion to adjourn. Councilwoman Hastings offered that motion with Councilman Aument seconding. The motion to adjourn was unanimously approved.
