

QUARRYVILLE BOROUGH AUTHORITY

MARCH 17, 2026

The Authority held its regular monthly meeting on March 17, 2026 at the Municipal Building. Chairman John Chase called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM with Authority members Mike Mankin, Donald Evans, Brian Braightmeyer, Brad Groff, Authority Manager Bill Lamparter, WWTP Chief Operator Clint Herr and Administrative Assistant Kelly Wyatt present.

Public Comment: No public comment.

Approval of Minutes: It was moved by John Chase and seconded by Donald Evans that the minutes of the February 17, 2026 Authority meeting be approved. The motion was unanimously approved.

Financial Report and Monthly Bills: It was moved by Brian Braightmeyer and seconded by Donald Evans to approve the February 28, 2026 financial report and ratify the February invoices in the amount of \$54,349.19. The motion was unanimously approved.

Chief Operator Report: Clint Herr reported that the Chemical Feed System and the UV Disinfection System are being rebuilt. Next month there will be some bigger than usual bills to replace the spare parts used.

Engineers Report: Rettew Engineering: The Authority reviewed the monthly report from Rettew and accepted it as written. Good's Store has now tapped into the water main on Fifth Street. Paving should be completed in the Spring.

Approve and Execute Documents for N. Hess Street Water Main Replacement Proj: Donald Evans moved to approve and execute the Anrich-Executed Construction Documents for the N Hess Street Water Main Replacement Project. This motion was seconded by Brian Braightmeyer and passed unanimously.

Discussion of Maximizing Grant Funding for N. Hess Street Water Main Replacement Project: Per GMS, to maximize the grant of \$212,500.00, we will be extending the 10 inch water main from North Hess Street to Church Street, adding a new fire hydrant and replacing an old one. The 15 percent of the project that the Authority will pay equals \$83,000.00. The Authority members are all in agreement with this.

Sewer Service Agreement: A motion was made by John Chase and seconded by Mike Mankin to approve the sewer service at 4432 Crosby Lane, 4434 Crosby Lane, 326 W Fritz Avenue and 21 Ridgewood Road. The motion was unanimously approved.

Public Comment: No public comment.

Adjournment: There being no further business, it was moved by Mike Mankin and seconded by Donald Evans that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was unanimously approved and the meeting was adjourned at 7:40pm.
