

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
April 8, 2025

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilman Braightmeyer, Councilman Kreider, Borough Manager Scott Peiffer and Assistant Borough Manager Michelle Evans.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion to approve the March 11, 2025 meeting minutes was made by Councilman Braightmeyer and seconded by Councilman Kreider. The motion was approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

a. Project Updates:

1. **West State/Fourth Intersection:** The Manager reported that Brian Miller from ELA will be the inspector for this project. JVI construction would like to start the week of April 14th. The project is approved but no permit has been issued by PennDOT.
2. **ELG Connector:** The Manager reported that concrete was poured, paving will be done once the weather gets warmer, landscaping is starting and signage is going in. This project is estimated to be complete the end of April.
3. **Geiger Avenue Complaint:** The committee discussed this matter and will wait to hear from the property owner.

NEW BUSINESS:

a. Parking Setbacks-Third Street & Fifth Street: The Committee talked about parking setbacks on Third & Fifth Street. The Committee would like to amend the ordinance for parking setbacks. Scott Peiffer will mark the setbacks at different footages and Jimmy Kreider will look at them and then a decision will be made as to the footage of the setback. After the Committee decides this setback, they will give Council the recommendation.

b.Fritz/Chestnut Street Intersection: The Committee discussed the potential dangers at the intersection of Fritz and Chestnut streets. The Committee would like to see All Way Stop Signs at this intersection. Scott Peiffer will reach out to LTAP to look into this safety concern.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm by motion from Councilman Braightmeyer and seconded by Councilman Kreider.
