

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
AUGUST 8, 2023

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilman Braightmeyer, Councilman Kreider and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer. Councilwoman Bowman was absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes of the July 11, 2023 meeting were reviewed with no comments.

OLD BUSINESS:

Lime Street Shoulder Update: The public works crew completed the oil and chip sealing of both shoulders of North Lime Street from State Street to the Borough Line. Eden Township assisted with the project.

NEW BUSINESS:

West Fifth Street Parking Issue: The Manager relayed a resident's concern on the narrow width of the roadway when vehicles are parked on both sides of Fifth Street from Summit Avenue to South Church Street. The Committee discussed limiting parking to one side of these 2 blocks of Fifth Street. The Borough Manager will poll the owners of the properties that front these 2 blocks for their input and report back to the Committee with the results.

Bank Avenue Bollard Request: A request for a flexible yellow bollard to be placed at the edge of the right of way on the north side of Bank Avenue was received from Nick Ragan of Alltypes Insurance. Trucks entering Bank Avenue have repeatedly damaged his building at this location. The Committee agreed that the Borough would place 1 flexible bollard at the corner of Bank Avenue and South Hess Street to see if that would help.

Speed Hump Recommendation: After a brief discussion, both members of the Committee present recommended that Council approve the installation of 3 speed humps on Stanton Road and 2 speed humps on Fifth Street at a cost not to exceed \$16,500.00. The funding would come from the capital reserve account. Councilwoman Bowman was not in attendance but relayed that she was against the recommendation via phone message prior to the meeting.

Salt Storage Building Storm Damage: A storm on July 28th blew a tree down that hit the roof of the salt storage shed causing truss damage. The damage was reported as a claim to our insurance carrier. The adjuster was scheduled to see the damage on 8/9/23.

Memorial Park Flag Project: Joann Black from the Quarryville Lions Club approached the Manager regarding a project in Memorial Park. They would like to add the flags of the five branches of the armed forces around the existing flag pole. The cost of the project is projected at \$25,000.00. The Lions Club would raise the funds for the project. The Manager also relayed that maybe the Borough would sponsor the project with the Lions Club donating the funds to the Borough for it. This would allow the Borough to apply for some foundation grants to assist with the funding. There will be more discussion forthcoming as more details become available.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
