

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
FEBRUARY 8, 2022

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 6:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilman Braightmeyer, Mayor Anthony Cavallaro, Maintenance Superintendent Bill Lamparter and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

OLD BUSINESS:

HUFFNAGLE PARK PATHWAY PAVING: Scott reported that he will check into the paperwork for using ARPA funding to repair and repave the pathways in Huffnagle Park. The proposal from Long's Asphalt is \$25,000.00. This is in the capital budget for 2022 utilizing ARPA funding. The latest guidance indicates that improvements to parks is allowable.

SERVICE TRUCK UPDATE: The chassis and tool body are currently at Lancaster Truck Bodies being assembled. The expected completion date is the end of February.

WEST FOURTH STREET TRAFFIC STUDY UPDATE: Scott provided current information on questions we had posed to PennDOT about the potential restrictions. The Borough can remove parking restrictions on South Church Street if that would help create a safer lane of travel for trucks that would be forced to travel South Church Street due to the possible restrictions on West Fourth Street.

NEW BUSINESS:

BRIDGE REPLACEMENT GRANTS: Scott and Bill met with Speaker Cutler's office in regard to funding the Broad and Second Street bridge/culvert replacements. His suggestion was to apply for Multimodal Transportation Funding. Scott spoke with GMS on this and they will apply for funding if we desire. Brian suggested we follow up on costs for inspection. The last inspection was 2010 and the condition was rated as poor at that time. Scott will contact ELA and PennDOT in regard to inspection estimates.

MEMORIAL PARK GRANT: Scott is looking into a grant possibility for adding to the riparian buffer at Memorial Park. The project may include repair to a damaged culvert pipe that flows into the stream from an inlet box on SR 472. Scott contacted ELA in regard to cost for design and permits for that part of the project. The grant is through PA American Water and the request maximum is \$10,000.00.
