

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
July 8, 2025

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilman Braightmeyer, Councilman Kreider, Councilwoman Bowman Maintenance Superintendent Bill Lamparter and Borough Manager Michelle Evans.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion to approve the April 8, 2025 meeting minutes was made by Councilman Kreider and seconded by Councilwoman Bowman. The motion was approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

a. Project Updates:

1. **West State/Fourth Intersection:** Bill Lamparter reported that the work has stopped because of a conflict with the water main piping. He reported that Council has given the go ahead for the change order to fix this issue and he is hoping work will start up again the week of July 14th.
2. **ELG Connector:** The Manager reported that all grant money has not been used so GMS has been working with DCED to use up the funds in a different scope for the ELG Connector. Plans for a bike station, bench, ADA parking space, some paving, landscaping, and to replace the deteriorated bridge railing etc. is being considered.
3. **Geiger Avenue Complaint:** No discussion on this matter.
4. **Parking Setbacks -Third Street & Fifth Street:** SIP will recommend to Council to ordinance this change in parking setbacks on the streets listed. Jimmy Kreider will email Michelle the footage of the setbacks.
5. **Fritz/Chestnut Street Intersection:** Marvin from LTAP was down to evaluate this intersection. His recommendation is to put the stop sign on Chestnut Street. SIP will bring this recommendation to Council to amend the current ordinance.

6. **State/Lime St. Traffic Signal:** Councilman Braightmeyer suggested inviting the Quarryville Fire Company and our engineer to a SIP meeting to go over concerns/ideas about this traffic signal project. ELA needed to know SIP's thoughts on the bump out and parking spaces at Magnolia Lane Properties apartment building. The options were: a 60-degree angle providing 7 parking spaces or a 50-degree angle providing 6 parking spaces. SIP opted for the 60-degree angle providing 7 parking spaces. The manager will contact ELA and let them know the preference.
7. **Update on Crack Sealing/Catch Basin Cleaning:** Bill Lamparter reported that watermain flushing is scheduled for July 28th and 29th 2025. Crack sealing is scheduled for August 5th thru August 8th 2025. Catch Basin cleaning is scheduled for August 13th thru August 15th 2025. Councilman Kreider stated that East Lampeter has a truck that cleans out catch basins, Bill Lamparter will contact them to see if we can use their truck.

NEW BUSINESS:

a. Intersection at 4th/Church St: Councilman Kreider reported that he has gotten complaints about the broken-up road at the intersection of 4th and Church. Bill Lamparter reported that they are going to fix that with Perma patch.

b. Maple Avenue Repair: Councilman Braightmeyer asked what is happening with Maple Avenue. Bill Lamparter reported that the surveyors have been to Maple Avenue but as of yet, we haven't heard anything further.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 8:50 pm by motion from Councilwoman Bowman and seconded by Councilman Kreider.
