

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
JUNE 5, 2023

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 5:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilman Braightmeyer, Councilman Kreider, Mayor Cavallaro and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer. Councilwoman Bowman was absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion to approve the minutes of the May 1, 2023 meeting was made by Councilman Braightmeyer and seconded by Councilman Kreider. The motion passed unanimously

OLD BUSINESS:

SPEED HUMP SURVEY UPDATE: The Committee discussed the placement and number of speed humps to be placed on Stanton Road and Fifth Street. The Manager was instructed to get costs for the placement of 3 speed humps on Stanton Road and 1 or 2 speed humps on Fifth Street.

LOCAL ROAD SAFETY PLAN (LRSP): The Manager reported that he had a conversation regarding the liability of the LRSP with the solicitor and it does not seem that the creation of the plan would put the Borough at an increased risk for liability. The Committee feels that this would be a good plan and recommends to Council to proceed.

MEADOW LANE PARKING ISSUE: A brief discussion was held on the issue of lack of parking on Meadow Lane which was brought up by several residents of Meadow Lane at the May 1, 2023 S/I/P meeting. The Committee agreed that there is little that can be done as the street parking is public and for anyone that desires to park there. The Committee sympathizes with the residents and acknowledges that the issue is due to some residents having multiple vehicles and no driveway space for parking but has no solution available for the problem.

NEW BUSINESS:

PROPOSED PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE - MEMORIAL PARK: Jim Paxson of the Quarryville Lions Club presented a plan for a pedestrian bridge that he would construct across the stream near South Lime Street and the south border of the park property line in order for those parking in the grass area along South Lime Street during the Solanco Fair to get across the stream

to the fairgrounds. The Committee felt it was a good idea but instructed the Manager to check with Solanco Engineering regarding permits needed and the Solicitor regarding liability. Scott will get back to Mr. Paxson after these questions are answered.

TRASH TRUCK ISSUES: Councilwoman Bowman called the Manager prior to the meeting to discuss the ongoing issue of early morning trash pick up by Cauler Container. The Committee had a brief discussion about next steps as this has been an ongoing issue. The Manager will contact Cauler Container regarding this.

MARLTON LANE INLETS: Councilman Kreider asked the maintenance department to look into loose bricks under the inlet box tops on Marlton Lane.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 5:50 pm.
