

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
MARCH 8, 2022

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 6:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilman Brightmeyer, Councilwoman Bowman, Councilman Kreider, Mayor Anthony Cavallaro, Maintenance Superintendent Bill Lamparter and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

OLD BUSINESS:

BROAD STREET AND SECOND STREET BRIDGE INSPECTIONS: After a brief discussion, all committee members agreed to recommend approval of the proposed bridge inspections at a cost of \$5,200.00 for inspection of the Broad Street and the Second Street bridges. The proposal is from Mackin Engineers who has the Lancaster County Inspection contract.

SERVICE TRUCK UPDATE: The truck was delivered today (March 8, 2022) and will be lettered as soon as possible.

WEST FOURTH STREET TRUCK RESTRICTIONS: After discussion, the committee recommends to Council that we hold a public meeting in regard to the restriction of truck traffic on West Fourth Street which may include removing parking on South Church Street between Fourth Street and Bank Avenue.

GRANT APPLICATION FOR MEMORIAL PARK STREAMBANK RESTORATION: The manager reported that he and Bill had met with George Smith III from ELA and Matt Vickers from R. Work Excavating at the site. We have determined that it should be possible to complete the project for \$10,000.00 which is the grant maximum. Scott will pursue the application which is due March 31, 2022.

NEW BUSINESS:

MEMORIAL PARK LOWER FIELD RENOVATION PROPOSAL: Solanco Youth Baseball has rented the lower ballfield at Memorial Park to play baseball. Currently the field is set up to play softball. The group is willing to enlarge the infield for baseball. We have traditionally provided Diamond-Tex for volunteer groups to renovate/maintain the fields. The group is willing to purchase any additional Diamond-Tex if needed. The Committee felt that they could proceed with the renovations.

FLEET ANTI-CORROSION TREATMENT: Scott reported that the Borough's pickup truck has been treated and the Authority's pickup truck is scheduled for treatment this month.

EAST STATE STREET-LIME STREET INTERSECTION: After brief discussion, the Committee agreed the intersection is in dire need of a traffic signal. The Manager will obtain an updated cost opinion for the Committee and Council to review. The last cost opinion was obtained in 2019.

FAIR PARADE ROUTE CHAIR PLACEMENT: Brian reminded the Committee about future discussion in regard to chair placement prior to the Fair Parade this year. We will review options at the next meeting.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 7:10 pm.
