

**BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE**  
**STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING**  
**MAY 1, 2023**

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 5:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilwoman Bowman, Councilman Braightmeyer, Councilman Kreider, Mayor Cavallaro and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Residents Mateo and Amber Constantino of 219 Meadow Lane and Betsy Carlee of 300 Meadow Lane addressed the Committee with a parking issue on Meadow Lane. A guest of another resident is parking 3 vehicles in the on-street parking right of way which does not allow adequate parking in front of resident's homes. The Committee sympathizes with the residents but the vehicles are licensed and registered and are parked legally. After discussion, the residents were told to petition for signatures of the other development residents and come to the Committee for some other options on parking in the development.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**LIME/STATE STREETS SIGNAL UPDATE:** The Manager updated the committee on a current cost opinion of the signal which includes \$59,000.00 for engineering/design. After discussion, the Committee decided to recommend to Borough Council that we proceed with engineering and design of the signal at State Street and Lime Street at a cost of \$59,000.00. The Borough's engineer, ELA will do the work. The Committee instructed Public Works and the Manager to check on the line of sight looking east from the North Lime Street stop bar.

**HUFFNAGLE PARK SECURITY CAMERAS:** Malstrom Alarm will be starting the camera installation on May 2, 2023. There were questions regarding installation of a camera at the upper pavilion. The Manager will check into this. Public Works Department will check into adding extra lighting in the pavilion as well.

**SPEED HUMP SURVEY UPDATE:** The Manager will continue to seek costs on the installation of the speed humps as well as technical assistance from LTAP on placement and technical specifications of the humps.

**TRAFFIC CIRCULATION STUDY UPDATE:** The Manager reported that he has reached out to Chris Metka of PennDOT Connects regarding funding of the traffic circulation study. He informed the Manager that he has forwarded the request to PennDOT Central Office along with the support of the County MPO for funding consideration.

**LOCAL ROAD SAFETY PLAN (LRSP):** The Manager reported that he provided copies of the answer from our solicitor regarding liability to Council for review. The Committee feels that this would be a good plan and recommends to Council to proceed.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**STATE/LIME INTERSECTION MARKINGS:** Copies of LTAP information sheets regarding low-cost intersection improvements were distributed. The Manager will look into the legal/permitting issues of street markings or flashing beacons for the sign.

**HUFFNAGLE PARK PATHWAY PAVING:** A cost estimate for paving all the pathways and blacktop areas in the park was received from Asphalt Repair Systems in the amount of \$41,500.00. It was discussed that this would be a capital project for the future and it should be considered in future budgeting.

**PEDESTRIAN PEDESTAL ISSUES:** After receiving a complaint regarding the pedestrian pedestal at Third and Hess Street, the Committee recommended to the Manager and Public Works that the pedestal be moved to Hess and Fourth Street during the summer school break as this intersection has a lot of pedestrian traffic during the summer season.

**MEETING DATE/TIME CHANGE:** There was discussion on the meeting date and time of Streets/ Infrastructure/Parks Committee. With the current time and date, it is a challenge for the committee to make recommendations to Borough Council as the Council meeting is held 2 hours after the S/I/P meeting. The Committee will look at other options.

**SIDEWALK ORDINANCE REVIEW:** A discussion was held regarding the current sidewalk ordinance and possible changes to that ordinance. The Committee will continue to review the ordinance for possible recommendations for changes.

**ADJOURNMENT:** Meeting adjourned at 6:00 pm.
