

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
OCTOBER 10, 2023

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilman Braightmeyer and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Joanne Black of the Quarryville Lions Club presented their idea of placing poles with the five (5) armed forces flags around the existing flagpole in Memorial Park. They would encircle the flagpole in a raised bed with plantings. The poles would be 25' high which is half the height of the existing flagpole. The cost is estimated to be around \$30,000.00 which they intend to raise over the next year or two. The Lions Club would also try to provide 1 set of flags per year to maintain the poles.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes of the September 12, 2023 meeting were reviewed.

OLD BUSINESS:

West Fifth Street Parking Issue: This item is tabled until the next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

South Hess Street Parking Issue: A teacher at Quarryville Elementary School suggested that the Borough look into painting parking lines on Hess Street across from the elementary school in order to fit the maximum number of vehicles in the parking zone. Councilman Braightmeyer and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer felt that this was unnecessary.

Land O'Lakes Grant: The Manager reported that he has applied for grant funds in the amount of \$4,500 for 3 bike racks, 2 dog clean up stations and a public art mural at the Lions Club french fry stand.

Williams Pipeline Grant: The Manager reported that he has applied for a grant in the amount of \$5,120 for 5 trash receptacles and 15 seasonal banners.

Capital Budget Items: The Manager reported that he will place \$20,000.00 in the capital budget for repairs to the wearing course on West Fourth Street.

Scott updated the committee with the following: The concrete is poured for the pad in Memorial Park for the donated park bench. Memorial Park has been core aerated to relieve compaction on the turf areas after the fall event

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
