

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING

October 12, 2021

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 6:00 PM at the Municipal Building. Councilman Aument called the meeting to order with the following persons present: Councilman Braightmeyer, Maintenance Superintendent Bill Lamparter and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

OLD BUSINESS:

2021 STREET PROJECT UPDATE: The Manager reported that full depth reclamation and base paving is completed and final wearing course paving is to be done on October 13, 2021.

NEW BUSINESS:

PARADE CHAIRS/SIDEWALK ORDINANCE: Scott gave an update on the answers that he has received from New Holland and Manheim on their issues with early chair placement. Both municipalities don't really enforce much. Manheim set a rule of "No chairs placed before 4 pm day of parade ", but is not enforcing it just requesting/suggesting. Committee will review further. Suggestions are to have notice placed in fair book and on fair website as well as posted along with No Parking signs.

PARK AVENUE/QPRC STORMWATER WORK: The Manager reported that work will begin tomorrow on Park Avenue to rectify the stormwater issues from Phase 3 development.

MEMORIAL PARK RIPARIAN BUFFER EDUCATION TRAIL GRANT: The Manager reported that we have received a grant from Lancaster County Community Foundation – Clean Water Alliance to create a short trail with signage at the riparian buffer on the Park Avenue side of the park. The grant amount is \$5323.00. Work will begin and be completed in the spring of 2022.

GIANT SEQUOIA TREE: The Manager reported that a resident has a potted Giant Sequoia Tree and is willing to donate to the Borough to be placed in one of the parks. There was discussion on where to put it and there seemed to be no real answer on a proper area to plant it. It was suggested that SECA may be another option as they have property that is open to the public. The Manager will follow up with the SECA Director to see if they have an appropriate place for the tree.

LOADER PURCHASE: The Manager reviewed the options of a loader replacement for the Maintenance Department. Scott suggested that the timing for purchase was optimum due to the high value of our trade in. There was discussion on leasing costs which we are awaiting and the fact that we currently have 2 leases on vehicles and would prefer to wait until one of those is completed. The matter was tabled.

OTHER CAPITAL PROJECTS: There was discussion on several other capital projects that are on the horizon including bridge/culvert replacement on Broad and Second St. and Stanton Road paving.

FOURTH STREET TRUCK RESTRICTION TRAFFIC STUDY: Discussion on funding the study for truck restrictions on West Fourth Street took place and the committee recommended proceeding ahead with the study if funding is available in the general engineering budget. Scott will verify that the cost of \$1975.00 from ARRO Consulting from 8/2020 is still valid. The recommendation will be placed on the November 1, 2021 Council Agenda.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 7:05pm.
