

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
OCTOBER 14, 2025

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilman Brightmeyer, Councilwoman Bowman, Maintenance Superintendent Bill Lamparter and Borough Manager Michelle Evans. Councilman Kreider was absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Randall Weaver, 4th Street, asked SIP to consider addressing the 2 trees on his property that he believes were harmed from the new driveway that is being put into his property from the 4th and State Street intersection work.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion to approve the September 9, 2025 meeting minutes was made by Councilman Brightmeyer and seconded by Councilwoman Bowman. The motion was approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

a. Project Updates:

1. **West State/Fourth Intersection:** Bill Lamparter reported that PennDot approved the stormwater improvements and construction will resume. PennDot's end date for paving is October 15th.
2. **Parking Setbacks -Third Street & Fifth Street:** Michelle Evans reported that she has not heard back from LTAP on this matter.
3. **Park Avenue Culvert:** Bill Lamparter reported that the engineering cost for the Park Avenue Culvert project is \$23,775.00. Council will have to approve the additional engineering cost for this project.
4. **Fourth Street Paving:** Bill Lamparter reported that paving of the intersection and a section near Fisher Paints will be done in November.
5. **Maple Ave. Project:** Bill Lamparter reported that complete reconstruction of Maple Avenue's cost opinion is \$895,895 with sidewalk price included. Without sidewalk price included the cost opinion is \$693,395.

6. **Lime & State Street Traffic Signal:** Bill Lamparter reported that the cost opinion for this project is \$412,000.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Huffnagle Park Tree:** Michelle Evans reported that Scott Kreider contacted her and would like to plant a tree at Huffnagle Park in honor of Scott Peiffer's years of service to the Borough. SIP will recommend to Council to allow Scott Kreider to purchase and plant a tree at Huffnagle Park.
2. **Future Paving Plans:** SIP discussed a 5-year plan for paving in the Borough. The top three streets that are to be considered for paving are as follows: Memorial Drive (patch), Stanton Road (mill & overlay), and Wheatfield Court (Mill & Overlay)
3. **Green Bicycle Road Markings:** Michelle Evans reported that a resident expressed concerns about the green bicycle road markings at the new ELG Trail Connector scaring horses. Michelle contacted PennDot and these markings are PennDot approved and that the studies from PennDot and FHWA suggests that green bicycle pavement markings do not specifically scare horses.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 8:24 pm by motion from Councilwoman Bowman and seconded by Councilman Briaghtmeyer.
