

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE
STREETS/INFRASTRUCTURE/PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
OCTOBER 8, 2024

The Streets/Infrastructure/Parks Committee held its meeting on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building with the following persons present: Councilman Braightmeyer, Councilwoman Bowman and Borough Manager Scott Peiffer.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion to approve the July 9, 2024 meeting minutes was made by Councilman Braightmeyer and seconded by Councilwoman Bowman. The motion was approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

Street Inventory Project: The Manager has started the development of a spreadsheet with street information including such items as: Right-of-Way width, pavement or cartway width, curbing, sidewalk, traffic counts, etc. Project completion target date is the end of 2024.

Project Updates: The Manager updated the Committee on the West End Intersection project. We are continuing to get notarized signatures on the easement documents. The bid due date is October 18, 2024.

The Second Street culvert project is going well with the completion projected to be in late October, 2024.

The Enola Low Grade Rail Trail Connector project has been awarded to SLC Excavating, LLC and will begin in the fall.

NEW BUSINESS:

Crack Sealing: The Borough Manager will coordinate with the Maintenance Superintendent on scheduling a day to seal pavement cracks in the Borough.

Inlet Box Cleaning: Councilwoman Bowman reported that she has seen stormwater inlet boxes that are pretty full of debris. The Manager will coordinate a day to clean out boxes either manually or with a vacuum truck in the fall.

Meadowview Tree Work: The Manager reported that he would like to do some right of way tree pruning along the streets of the Meadowview Development.

Maple Avenue Reconstruction: The Manger has requested ELA to provide an engineering/design cost estimate for Maple Avenue so that it can be in the 2025 budget.

ADJOURNMENT: Meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm by motion from Councilwoman Bowman and second by Councilman Braightmeyer..
