

BOROUGH OF QUARRYVILLE – COUNCIL MINUTES

WORK SESSION – DECEMBER 28, 2020

Borough Council held a Work Session on the above date at 7:00 PM at the Municipal Building. Council President Joy Kemper called the meeting to order with the following persons present: Council Members Susan Noel, Rick Aument, Jim Kreider, and Diane Hastings. Borough Manager Scott Peiffer was also in attendance.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

MANAGER'S REPORT:

2021 Final Budget- The Manager presented the final 2021 budget for review and adoption. A motion to adopt the 2021 budget was made by Councilwoman Noel and seconded by Councilman Aument. The motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

2021 Meeting Calendar- The proposed public meeting calendar for 2021 contained some wrong dates and the amended calendar was presented for review and adoption. A motion to adopt the amended 2021 public meeting calendar was made by Councilwoman Hastings and seconded by Councilman Kreider. The motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

Police Department Policies and Procedures- Councilwoman Noel followed up on information that she presented at the November Work Session about companies that would provide and update policies and procedures for the Police Department. Councilwoman Noel asked Council to consider possible budget savings from this year be applied to purchase the Lexipol or a comparable system in 2021. Councilwoman Noel made a motion to earmark \$15,000 in savings from the 2020 budget for use toward purchasing or subscribing to a system that would provide the police policies/procedures and updates for the department. Councilman Kreider seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: At 7:12 PM, Council President Kemper called for a motion to enter into Executive Session for personnel/police health benefits. Councilwoman Noel offered that motion and Councilman Aument seconded the motion. The motion to enter into Executive Session passed unanimously.

RETURN TO REGULAR SESSION: At 7:35 PM, Council returned to regular session.

A motion to approve the Teamsters Health and Welfare Addendum Sections 1,2,3&5 only was made by Councilwoman Hastings and seconded by Councilman Aument. The motion passed unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT: At 7:40 PM, Council President Kemper called for a motion to adjourn. Councilwoman Noel offered that motion with Councilman Aument seconding. The motion to adjourn was unanimously approved.
